## **Life Group Discussion Questions**

**Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

Opening question: What are your plans for Thanksgiving? What are you looking forward to? What are you not looking forward to?

### **Study Questions:**

Read Philippians 2:1-11. What stands out to you from these verses?

What are some things God has done that you are particularly thankful for? How does being grateful to God help you serve others better?

What does it mean to “consider others as better than yourselves”? How do Christ’s actions (verses 6-8) demonstrate humility and a concern for others? What are your thoughts on the quote from C.S. Lewis, “Humility isn’t thinking less of yourself, it is thinking of yourself less”?

If you were seeking to have the same attitude as Christ, how do you think your life would be different?

Rob talked about family and the importance of serving and loving our family, what does that look like for you, especially during the holidays?

When you think of someone who truly serves others, what words, actions or character qualities would you use to describe them?

What makes it difficult for us to serve others and be humble? Who in your life is difficult to serve? How can you be a better servant in that relationship?

Rob also talked about the importance of serving our church family and us being the church. What are some of the needs you see in our church and what are some of the ways you can get involved to help serve (if not already serving)?
